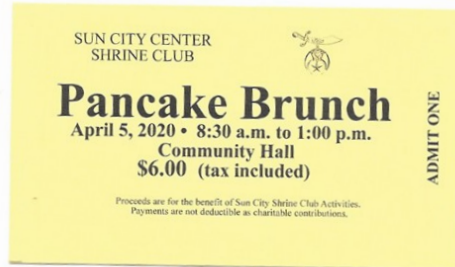

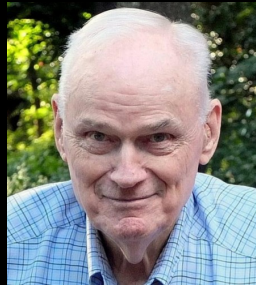

In Loving Memory



Charles M. East, Jr. of Charlotte, 93, died February 28, 2020 at Carriage Club. He was born September 16, 1926 in Princeton, IN to the late Charles M. East, Sr. and Mona Corbin East. Charlie graduated from New Albany High School in 1944 and the University of Omaha in 1964.

COL East was an Airborne Infantry Officer and veteran of World War II, Korea and Vietnam. He spent his formative years in airborne units, in Japan, in Alaska, in Europe and in covert assignments in Sub-Saharan Africa plus the Middle East. He graduated from the Infantry Officer Candidate School, the Armor Advanced Course, the Command and General Staff College, the Army War College and the Canadian National Defense College. His decorations include three Legions of Merit, two Bronze Stars, two Combat Infantryman's Badges, the Master Parachutist Badge, the Pathfinder Badge as well as numerous campaign ribbons.

A service to celebrate Charlie's life was conducted on Wednesday, March 4, 2020 at 2:00 pm in the Chapel at Covenant Presbyterian Church with inurnment later at the Florida National Cemetery in Bushnell, FL.
