
SCC Shrine Club's Can Tabs Donations

The Chaplain's Corner

By Noble Robert Bennett

1 Thessalonians 1:1-10 THE ELEMENTS OF A COMPLETE TESTIMONY

Intro: Paul was thankful for the Thessalonians and for the faith they so clearly and openly displayed. It is evident from reading this passage that this church made an impact in their day. But, their devotion to Jesus Christ still speaks today.

This ancient church gives us a clear example of what the witness of every church should be. As you know, when we speak of the church, we are speaking of the people who make up the church. Each of us has a testimony as an individual, and we have a collective testimony as a church. Paul is writing these words to the church. He is commending them for their clear testimony for Jesus Christ.

Now, whether we like it or not, our church has a witness in the

community. People see us and they see how we conduct ourselves and they form opinions about us, and about our Lord, based on what they see. These ancient Thessalonian believers demonstrated a complete testimony in their day. We should desire to demonstrate nothing less before this world.

This passage reveals the elements that came together to allow these believers to display a complete witness. I would like for us to place our church alongside this ancient church. We need to examine ourselves and see whether the same elements that marked their witness mark ours. I see, from this text, that by possessing certain elements every church can manifest a complete testimony.

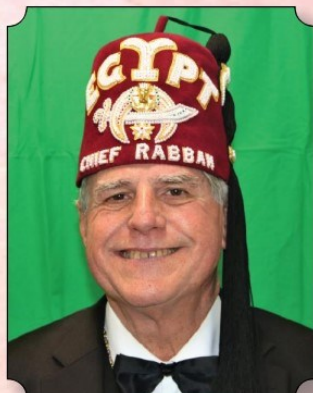

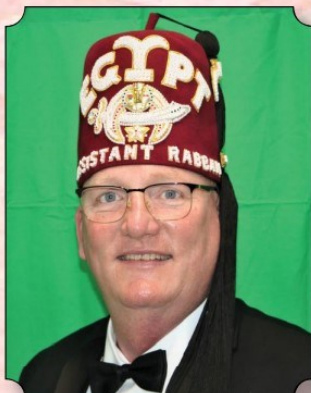
