

Dear Nobles and Ladies,

The Sun City Center Shrine Club is proposing the purchase of an eight-passenger golf cart with the objective of promoting the Club, Egypt Shrine & Shrine Philanthropy in Sun City Center and local communities and to **ATTRACT NEW MEMBERS**.

The Club Board of Directors has voted to approve the purchase of the eight-passenger golf cart with the intent of raising significant funds through membership contributions. Illustrious Sir Reggie Guier and Egypt Shrine have approved the purchase with the Club's intent of raising significant funding from membership contributions and are satisfied proper procedures were followed.

The Club, like many Masonic Bodies are facing decreased membership. We have seen a decline from the 2012 roster of 124 Nobles to 98 in 2018, this is twenty-one (21) percent less Nobles. Granted we are adding new members but not at a pace to offset this. If this rate of decline continues it is projected there would be seventy-six (76) Nobles in the Club in 2025. This would seriously impair the Club's ability to continue operating the semi-annual pancake brunches, our primary fund-raising event.

PROPOSED BENEFITS OF THE CART

- Attract **NEW** club members
- Easy access for 8 Nobles to participate in parades
- Participation in the Annual Sun City Center Holiday Golf Cart Parade
- Egypt Temple to be in more parades in 2019 that SCC Shrine Club can participate
- Unique & memorable visibility of the Club and Shrine in any parade or event

To date five Nobles have contributed a total of \$1,020. An individual has come forward and offered to match the funds raised by the Nobility with the hopes of creating unity within the Club and advancing the visibility of the Shrine. The attached Contribution Plan offers various contribution levels and the respective recognition. The cost of the cart is estimated to be under \$13,000 and the committee is working with local dealers to get better pricing.

Thank you for your consideration in supporting this project and your continued support of the Shrine Philanthropy!
