The Fall Pancake Brunch Ticket Sales on Friday and Saturday October 27 and 28 really stretched us thin, manpower wise. So thin, we had to fore go participating at Win-Dixie and Publix in Apollo Beach and we could not cover all the usual shifts at the SCC Walmart and Publix. However due to the generosity of the people on the shifts that Nobles were able to cover,--a number of Nobles seeing the dire - straights we were in stepped-up and thankfully took multiple shifts on both days- the total money collected during Friday and Saturday at the SCC venues, was very impressive.

The actual Tickets purchased and presented at the Sunday Pancake Brunch caused "the clicker" to register some 1114 paying customers. It is believed, by those who have observed a number of fund-raising drives, and worked a number of campaigns, the actual number of individuals fed was more near 1200 to 1250 adults then 1114.

The Bus trip to Egypt by 19 SCC Nobles, plus the three SCCSC Nobles who arrived by other transportation means brought the total number of Divan Escorts to at least 22 SCCSC Nobles-- a huge success when judged from many and assorted angles.

First, it was the largest number of SCCSC Nobles to attend together a Temple Stated Meeting in a very, very long time.

Second, the 22 Nobles from Sun City Center Shrine Club were the last to ever escort the reigning Divan within the Stu Lang facility.

Third, the attending 22 SCCSC Nobles all participated in the Club's presentation of multiple checks to the Potentate bringing the total contributions by the Sun City Center Shrine Club, in Club Year 2017, to a total of \$17,896.50.

Fourth, the 22 attending SCCSC Nobles standing before the "standing room only", packed- house of Stated Meeting attendees, received a standing ovation of Nobles and Divan members in recognition of the accomplishments and continual "cutting-edge" participation of **the** Sun City Center Shrine Club.

Fifth, the 22 Nobles of SCCSC were in attendance when in response to the SCCSC presentations, the 2017 Temple Potentate, James Litch exclaimed, "Sometimes 'thanks,' just isn't enough!"

Sixth, the 22 SCCSC attending Nobles witnessed and heard Illustrious Sir, James Litch reporting for the Divan, make an outstanding power point presentation, presenting:

- a. the adjacent Palm River property the Divan was recommending the Temple purchase as the site of a new Temple facility;



b. both the positive and negative aspects of the proposed property and the purchase at the current date;

c. mediation, reasons and answers to expressions, concerns and questions voiced by attentive Nobility. Eighth, the 22 individual SCCSC Nobility, participated in a truly historic vote where-by the Temple Year 2017 Divan was authorized to invest \$2,100,000.00 of Temple Capitol Funds in the purchase of specific Palm River adjacent property. Purchase for the expressed purpose of erecting a new Temple facility that remains to be designed, specified, and accepted.

The only negative connected with the bus trip and the attending of the November Stated Temple Meeting is that more SCCSC Nobles did not *choose* to take advantage of the amenities the Club provided and experience first-hand what the Temple under the leadership of Illustrious Sir James Litch and the current Divan has and is accomplishing and providing.

Since the collective visit to the Temple, Nobles of SCCSC have fostered:

a. sizeable successes at the annual, *Hi Neighbor* community-wide event held in Community Hall during early November of each year;

b. a new *Welcome Masons & Shriners* event hosted in the Kings Point Clubhouse by Nobles Dale Province, Don Stillson, James D. Porrett, Dave Rubin and Larry Wing in the Kings Point Clubhouse.

When you read this offering, another successful Men's Night Out, a male focus event in November, will have been held under the direction of Chairman, Noble Don Stillson.
