

The Chaplain's Corner

2 Tim: 3-16 The Bible

A good word that describes the Bible is the word "unique". The dictionary defines the word "unique" as follows, "1. only one: being the only one of its kind 2. better than others: superior to all others 3. unusual: different from others in a way that makes something worthy of note." It is the only book of its kind in existence! Several features point out its uniqueness, and by way of introduction, I want to share those features with you today.

- The Bible was written over a period of 1,500 years
- The Bible was written by over 40 different authors (Among them were kings, military leaders, peasants, philosophers, fishermen, tax collectors, poets, statesmen, musicians, scholars and shepherds.)
- The Bible was written in many different places, at many different times and by people experiencing many different moods.
- The Bible was written on three continents: Asia, Africa and Europe.
- The Bible was written in three different languages: *Hebrew, Greek and Aramaic*.
- The Bible is written with many different literary styles: **Prose, poetry, historical narra**tive, romance, law, biography, parable, allegory and prophecy.
- The Bible addresses hundreds of difficult issues without a single contradiction.
- The Bible is a book of great diversity, yet, in spite of this, it unfolds a single continuous story, and it does so without ever contradicting itself.
- The Bible has for its main character God Himself, made known through the person of His Son, the Lord Jesus Christ.

Yes, the Bible is a unique book! But, this uniqueness was not accidental, it was purposeful. How can this be? The Bible achieves its uniqueness through a process known as Inspiration. It is that process that I would like for us to investigate together today. Our text, verse 16, says that "All scripture is given by inspiration of God". The word

"inspiration" literally means "God

breathed".





13-Day Irish Classic Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Dublin City Tour & Pearse Lyons Distillery

Your tour begins at 2:00 PM at your Dublin hotel. Take a panoramic tour of Dublin, seeing such sights as elegant Georgian townhouses, St. Stephen's Green and the River Liffey. Visit the Pearse Lyons Distillery, Dublin's only independent, family-owned distillery, in the former St James's Church in the Liberties. Taste the whiskey and hear tales dating back to the 12th century as you tour this lovingly restored church. Enjoy a welcome drink with your group before dining independently.

Day 2: Down Cathedral, The St Patrick Centre, Crumlin Road Gaol & Belfast

Visit Down Cathedral where St Patrick's historical burial site is marked by a huge boulder. Immerse yourself in his work, life, and times in the nearby St Patrick Centre. Explore Crumlin Road Gaol and see what prison life was like through the ages. Head to central Belfast for some time to relax before dinner at your hotel. (B, D)

Day 3: Titanic Belfast & Belfast Walking Tour

Tour central Belfast to see Victorian buildings, the imposing City Hall in Donegall Square, and the shipyards where RMS Titanic was built in 1912. Day 5: Westport & Westport Walking Tour


