The Sun City Center Shrine Club welcomes Noble Robert F. (Bob) Burnham as a new member of our Shrine Club.

Noble Bob Burnham was born in Stamford, Connecticut; his Father and Grandfather were both Masons. Bob attended schools in Darien, Conn. and he graduated from Mt. Hermon School in Massachusetts in 1951. He graduated from the University of Connecticut in 1955 with a BS in Agriculture. Bob served two years in the US Army (1956-57) and 16 months in Landshut, Germany with the 11th Armored Cavalry Regiment. Assigned to a Tank Company, Bob drove an ammo truck with "Explosives" and "Sprengstoff" signs on it. Bob said, "Try that today in Iraq!" He worked 10 years as a technician with Eastern Al Association and predecessors in New England States. Bob also worked 30 years with Holstein Association in Brattleboro, Vermont, the US headquarters for registration and performance records for the Holstein breed of dairy cattle, in Data Processing and retired in 1992. Bob lived more than 40 years in Hinsdale, New Hampshire.

Bob was raised March 27, 1993 in Golden Rule Lodge in Hinsdale and served as Junior Deacon. He was transferred to Jerusalem Lodge, New Hampshire, when Golden Rule Lodge was dissolved. Later in 1993, Noble Bob became a 32 degree Scottish Rite Mason and joined Cairo Shrine Temple, both in Vermont and he served in the Oriental Band.

In 2006, Bob sold his house in Hinsdale and began living full time in his Bounder Motorhome. In the winter months, he stays in the Masonic Park and Youth Camp in Wimauma, FL., while splitting the summer months at his daughters' homes in Maine and Vermont. Noble Bob became a Florida resident in 2006.

His hobbies and other activities are: Lions Club, Hinsdale, NH, where he has served 48 years. He was the NH Lions District Webmaster and Extension Chairman for many years. Several new Lions Clubs were chartered as a result of his extension work. Bob is also a 50 year member of the Elks Club in Brattleboro, Vermont. Bob is currently serving as president, webmaster and newsletter editor for the Granite Staters Chapter of the Family Motor Coach Association (FMCA). Bob also studies Genealogy (for New England and Pennsylvania Moravian roots) and has many records. Noble Bob also enjoys Photography and Stamp Collection and he is still collecting!


